The Wyandotte Boat Club Rowing Camps provide an opportunity to learn the basics of rowing in a fun environment. Register today – both camps will be limited to 50 rowers.

Youth Rowing Camps: For students entering 6th– 8th grades.

High School Rowing Camp: For students entering 9th – 12th grades.

- No experience needed, camps will teach the fundamentals of rowing
- Camps will run Monday–Friday for two weeks for a total of 20 instruction hours
- Camp fee of \$125 which includes: introduction into the sport of rowing; proper protocol in the Boathouse; technical instruction on rowing machines and water; video keepsake; a camp t-shirt; Regatta and a picnic on the last day.
- All rowers must complete a basic swim test that will be held on Day 2 of each session @ the Downriver YMCA
- All rowing boats will be accompanied by a motor launch with WBC–approved coaches, and experienced rowers will join the campers in each boat.
- Sessions are held rain or shine: If weather doesn't allow on–water rowing, WBC has multiple options to teach rowing in the boathouse.
